- Offers a solid basis from which to pursue onto university
- 65.2% of students graduate (in 4 years or less)
(Provincial average: 48.9%)
- Over 90% of graduates undertake university studies
- 99.3% first attempt success rate in the English exit exam

DISCOVERY PROFILE

- For curious students
 - **Who are interested in social sciences**
 - **Who want to explore and discover their world and society**
- Most flexible profile
- Allows discovery of many social sciences
- Without mathematics

PSYCHOLOGY, SOCIETY AND HEALTH PROFILE

- For students interested in psychology, sociology and health issues
- Obligatory course in sociology in 1st year
- Specialized courses in 2nd year:
 - **Biology**
 - **Advanced quantitative methods**
 - **Multidisciplinary course about health issues**
- Gives access to university programs in:
 - **Psychology, criminology, social work, etc...**
- Without mathematics

INTERNATIONAL PROFILE

- For students interested by international matters
- Obligatory course in geography in 1st year
- Specialized courses in 2nd year:
 - **4 International courses**
 - **Obligatory language course**
- Without mathematics

COMMERCE PROFILE

- For students interested by business world
- Obligatory courses:
 - **Introduction to business**
 - **3 mathematics courses**
 - **Microeconomics**
- Pre-requisite: TS5 or SN5
- Gives access to university programs in business administration

MATHEMATICS PROFILE

- For students interested in both social science and mathematics
- 3 mathematics courses:
- Pre-requisites: TS5 or SN5
- Gives access to university programs requiring mathematics

INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE

- Accessible to all profiles
- Conditions:
 - **2 international courses**
 - **Knowledge of a third language**
 - ***Integrative Activity (IA)* topic with an international perspective**

DOUBLE DECS IN SOCIAL SCIENCE

- Option 1: Social Science & Science (200.12)
 - Option 2: Social Science & Arts, Literature and Culture (ALC) (300.16)

- **Completing both DEC requirements in three years;**
 - **Receiving both diplomas;**
