

COVID-19 MEASURES



How will my classes be delivered for the Winter semester?

Unless directives from the Ministry change during the semester, all courses for the Winter 2021 semester will be online, except for science laboratories which will be held on campus. If at one point we have the authorization from the government, other punctual class activities, such as exams, could take place on campus throughout the semester. You will then be informed by your teachers of the time and date of such in presence activities.

Once the semester has started, which entrance should I use to access the College?

You will access the College using entrance B (parking). Upon arrival, you will need to identify yourself **using the QR code** posted on the doors and proceed to washing your hands. This door will be open from 8.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.

After 4.00 p.m., students will have to use entrance B.

Do I have to wear a mask in the College?

Wearing a **procedure mask** is mandatory everywhere inside the College. You can only remove your mask once you are seated in a classroom alone or while eating respecting social distancing. As requested by the Ministry, the classrooms will be arranged to allow each student to be 2 meters apart. During laboratories, wearing a procedure mask will be mandatory as well as respecting other safety measures. If you forget your mask, it will be possible to purchase one for \$2 at the reception desk.

BOOKSTORE

- Access the *Bookstore Express* here: http://BookstoreSLC.crc-sher.qc.ca/ as of Friday, January 15, in the morning.
- Choose the books you want to purchase
 - Please note that your book list is associated to your current class schedule. If you wish to change courses, please wait for your new schedule before buying your books. It will be possible to come back on campus to get your books after the Welcome Days once your schedule is adjusted.
- Between January 15 and 22, you will need to enter the College by using Door B (parking entrance). Only the books in inventory will be available for purchase. If NA is shown online next to your book, it means your book is not in inventory and will have to be purchased later.
- Enter email to receive your payment receipt. KEEP THIS EMAIL. We will need to see it when you pick up your books.
- Books will be ready two business days after your order. For example, if you place your order between Friday 3:00 p.m. and Sunday night, your order will be ready for pick-up the following Tuesday. Present yourself at the college with your student card and your receipt to pick up your order. From January 18 to 29, 2021, Bookstore orders will be distributed in the auditorium and open hours will be from 8:00 to 16:00.





BOOK RETURNS

Returns will be processed between February 8 to 26, 2021 ONLY.

Refunds will be handled as follows:

You must have all original receipts. If your book was wrapped, you must bring it back wrapped. No refunds or exchanges for unwrapped books.

No refunds on all course packs.

No refund on lab coats, calculators, molecular fits, SLC clothing, eyeglasses, masks & cards (ENG).

If a book has publisher's misprint/default, an exchange will always be given.





LABS

Five different classrooms (328, 344, 350, 351, and 372) will be reserved for students who need to attend an online class before or after a lab.

You do not need to reserve a seat as they will be accessible on a first come first serve basis.

You will be able to connect to the College's Wi-Fi network.

For personal work, the library as well as the Atrium of the Student Centre will be accessible.


WORKSHOPS






ONLINE COURSES

COURSE CHANGES

The deadline for course changes is 4:00 p.m. on **Friday, January 29,** 2021. The college reserves the right to make changes to the timetable without notice. Make sure to check your schedule on a daily basis for changes. If you are no longer attending St. Lawrence and have received a schedule, please contact Betty Ableson (bettya@slc.qc.ca) immediately to cancel your registration. You must use the Course Schedule Modification Module, which was activated at the same time as the schedules were made available and will remain open until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, January 29, 2021. This module allows you to view other schedule possibilities depending on the number of spots available in a given class. There may be no other schedule for your program when you try viewing possibilities; however, you may use the Course Schedule Modification Module at different times during the day since other students may drop a course at any time. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for every schedule modification you make.

Only students with the following reasons may meet an advisor for schedule changes by contacting Alexandre Roussel by Mio:

- You are missing one or more courses
- You have too many courses in your schedule
- You failed a course and no longer have the prerequisite to take a course.
- You have no lunch hour in your schedule
- · You have a medical reason (medical note required).

Note: You must officially withdraw from a course by meeting with the Academic Advisor, Alexandre Roussel, if you do not want to receive a failing grade No longer going to class is not considered an official withdrawal.

IMPORTANT: Dropping a course has an immediate and direct impact on your academic progression. The College cannot guarantee in which semester an abandoned course will be offered again. Dropping out of a prerequisite course may extend the duration of your studies. Contact Alexandre Roussel before choosing to stop attending a course.










STUDENT ID CARDS

How to reserve a book or access online research:




LOCKERS

FOOD SERVICES

CAFETERIA

Cafeteria will be closed this semester due to COVID-19. Vending machines will not be functional.

MICROWAVES

Microwaves will not be functional this Fall semester. We suggest you bring a cold meal or thermos. Spaces will be provided for you to eat in the cafeteria if the two-metre social distancing measure is respected.
