### APPLICATION FEE

All students who apply for admission or re-admission must pay a \$30.00 application fee. This fee is payable at the time of application and is non-refundable.

### FULL-TIME STUDENTS (Canadian citizens and landed immigrants)

A full-time student is one who is enrolled in at least four (4) courses or (180 hours of class) per semester.

### NON-RESIDENT FEE

In addition to regular fees, if you are a Canadian Citizen but not a Québec Resident, the following Non-Resident Fees must also be paid:

### FOREIGN STUDENTS

Applicants who do not have Canadian citizenship or permanent residence status may be considered for admission provided they possess a secondary school background which is equivalent to the Québec Diploma of Secondary studies.
