

Applying for admission to Cegep Champlain - St Lawrence

Before starting to apply, please note the following:

Application Deadlines

- March 1 for the Fall semester beginning in August (our application system is open from mid-January to March 1)
- November 1 for the Winter semester beginning in January (our application system is open from mid-September to November 1)


Note: Late applications will only be considered after we have processed all applications received on time, and then only if spaces are still available. Offers of admission are normally sent in early April for the Fall semester and early December for the Winter semester.

Payments for application processing


Application fees must be paid online by credit card via the application system in order to complete the application.

Before starting your application and filling out the form, make sure you have access to one of the following payment methods available to process your application payment, otherwise your application cannot be completed and you will have to start the process again.

Credit Card




DEBIT Card



No need for a credit card to pay online. A **Visa DEBIT** or **MasterCard DEBIT** compatible bank card works just fine. Your payment is then directly debited from your bank account.

If your bank card is not compatible with Visa DEBIT or Mastercard DEBIT, simply ask your bank to add this feature to your card. Select your bank card to find out more.

Desjardins PREPAID Card / Gift Card



The Desjardins PREPAID card is charged via AccesD, and allows you to pay online without a credit card. Visit the [Desjardins website](#) to get one.

The system also accepts Visa and Mastercard Gift Cards. These cards are available in several outlets, such as Grocery stores, Convenience stores and Coopsco.

Fees for application processing

These are the payments that must be made to complete the admission application process

Payments for everyone

- \$30 Application Fee (non-refundable)
- \$35 English Level Assessment (If you come from an English educational institution in Québec; you will not be asked to write the English Assessment and any excess fee paid regarding this assessment will be refunded or credited to your semester fee should you be accepted)

Payments for students who are from a high school in a province outside of Québec and Foreign students

- \$75 Transcript Evaluation Fee (non-refundable) to have your academic background evaluated by an outside agency, SRACQ. If this fee is generated when you apply it must be paid along with other application fees. If this fee is requested later, you will be able to pay by cheque or money order, payable to Champlain Regional College.

Additional costs per semester to consider

- Canadian students who are not deemed to be residents of Québec will be required to pay additional fees of \$1,780 per semester under Québec law (subject to change without notice).
- Foreign students, along with official immigration documents, must provide proof of enrollment in a comprehensive health and accident insurance plan, and will also be required to pay additional fees of \$7,000 per semester under Québec law (subject to change without notice)

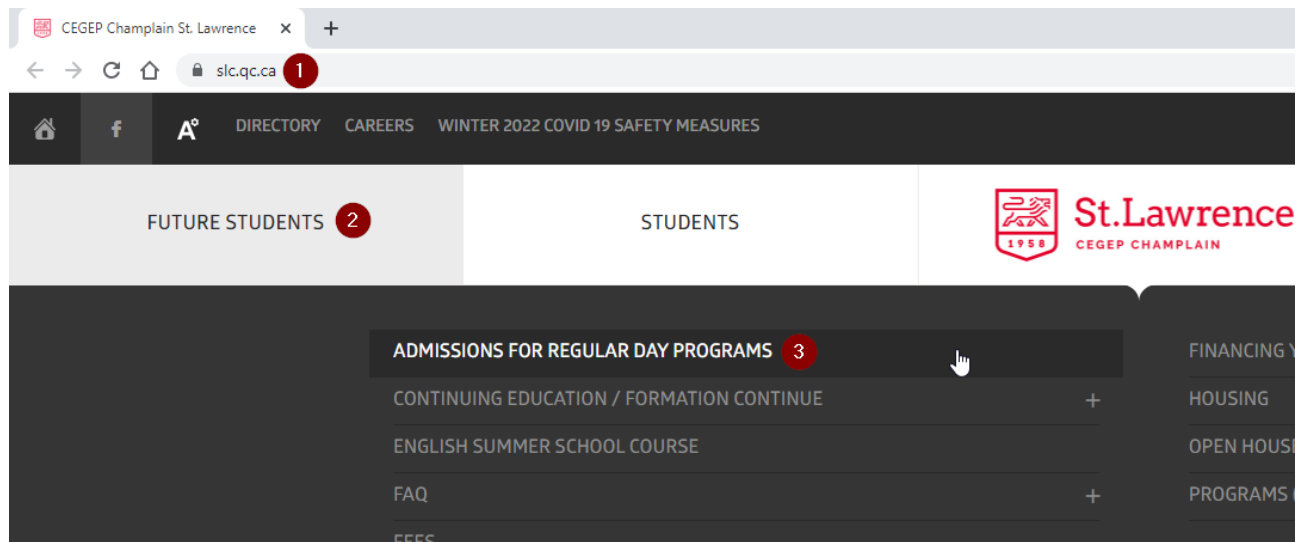
English Level Assessment Test

If you **do not come from an English educational institution in Quebec** you will need to make an English level assessment test. The one-hour test allows us to ensure you are ready for college studies in English. Within a week or two of the application system closing, you will receive an email with details pertaining to the online English Level Assessment Test.

How to apply

Keep in mind that the form will be enabled only within the established admission dates, outside of these dates no request can be made.

We recommend that you review the last section of the web page to know the documents that will be required according to your situation.

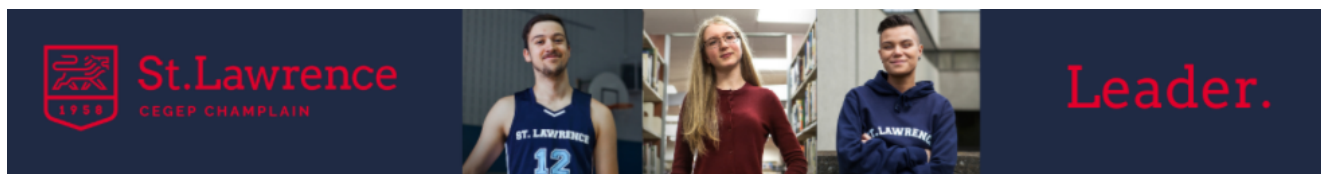
